November 10, 2009

Jeff Hartman called the meeting to order. The minutes from the October 20, 2009, meeting were approved as read.

TREASURER'S REPORT--Stephen Ayres read the treasurer's report. A copy will be filed with the minutes of the meeting. He reported that they are in the process of putting together a bill for the use of the trailer in the amount of \$969.00. This will be presented to Ms. Anderson so that she will not lose funds budgeted for truck rental.

COMMITTEE REPORTS--Jeff reported that all home games are now over. An inventory of soft drinks will be made and Coke will be contacted to pick up excess. Robin Barrington suggested that a chili cook off might be a possibility.

OLD BUSINESS--Jeff stated he is trying to reach Colleen Fowler for a list of ingredients for the gumbo. We will ask parents to donate food items as in the past. Tea will be from Chicken Express. Potato salad and desserts will be donated. We will start cooking on Monday, December 7. Help will be needed for set up and serving. Mr. Leyendecker will print tickets for us. Cost will be \$7.00 per ticket. Last year we made approximately \$4,000. Emily Lee is getting items for the silent auction.

Emily Lee is trying to have the tickets printed for the Carnival Cruise once we decide on the tickets.

NEW BUSINESS--We have accepted the resignation of the 2nd Vice President leaving a position open on the Board.

There is an upcoming trip in March. It is still undecided if it will be a bus trip or an airline trip. A current summary of points was distributed to those present at the meeting. A question was
